Oblikuj zapis v zvezek. Prepiši po NAJMANJ en primer povedi, ostale so za lažje razumevanje:

IF CLAUSES TYPE 2 (pogojni odvisniki tipa 2)

Drugi tip (Type 2) pogojnega odvisnika se nanaša **na sedanjost**. Pogoj je **neuresničljiv**, vendar v nekaterih primerih *obstajajo potencialne možnosti za njegovo uresničitev*.

Sestavljata ga **dva dela**, v obeh delih je prisoten glagol.

V glavnem stavku uporabimo 'would + nedoločnik', v odvisnem stavku pa Past Simple.

Primer: If *I had* a friend, *I would be* very happy.

vrsta Type	pogojni stavek If Clause (condition)	glavni stavek Main Clause
Type 2	If + Past Simple (osebek + glagol)	present conditional (osebek + would + nedoločnik)

Uporaba:

The type 2 is used to express *dreams, unreal situations and things that are unlikely to happen* - a hypothetical condition and its probable result.

These sentences are not based on the actual situation. The time is now or any time.

Povedi temeljijo na namišljenih pogojih. Z njimi NE govorimo o resničnem svetu, temveč o možnih situacijah ali sanjarjenju.

'If' **ne** moremo nadomestiti z 'when/whenever'.

Če to ponovno izrazimo v % - 0-5% - le malo verjetno, da se bi to zgodilo, ali pa le hipotetične situacije, ki se ne morejo uresničiti.

Primeri:

- **If the weather wasn't so bad, we would go to the park. (But the weather is bad so we can't go.)**
- **If you really loved me, you would buy me a diamond ring. (blackmail ☺)**
- **If I knew where she lived, I would go and see her. (but I don't know)**

Pri drugem tipu odvisnika uporabimo 'were' namesto 'was' z osebki 'I, he/she, it':

- **If I were the Queen of England, I would give everyone a chicken. (But I am not the Queen.)**
- **If it weren't snowy, I would go out. (But it is snowing outside.)**

Vrstni red stavkov lahko spremojamo brez vpliva na pomen.

Če se poved začne s pogojnim stavkom (if), uporabimo vejico:

- **If it rained, you would get wet.**
- **You would get wet if it rained.**
- **If you went to bed earlier, you wouldn't be so tired.**
- **You wouldn't be so tired if you went to bed earlier.**
- **If she fell, she would hurt herself.**
- **She would hurt herself if she fell.**

V nikalni povedi namesto 'if' uporabimo 'unless' (=če ne). Dela povedi, v katerem je veznik 'unless', ne smemo nikoli zanikati:

- **Unless you didn't leave, I would call the police.**

Pravilno je:

- **Unless you left, I'd call the police.**
- ali: **If she didn't leave, I'd call the police.**

'Would' včasih nadomestimo z drugim modalnim glagolom:

- **If I understood what the teacher said, I could tell you.**
